

Connecting to the Rehoboth Network from the outside using Nfuse.rcsnm.org

Rehoboth Parents and Students:

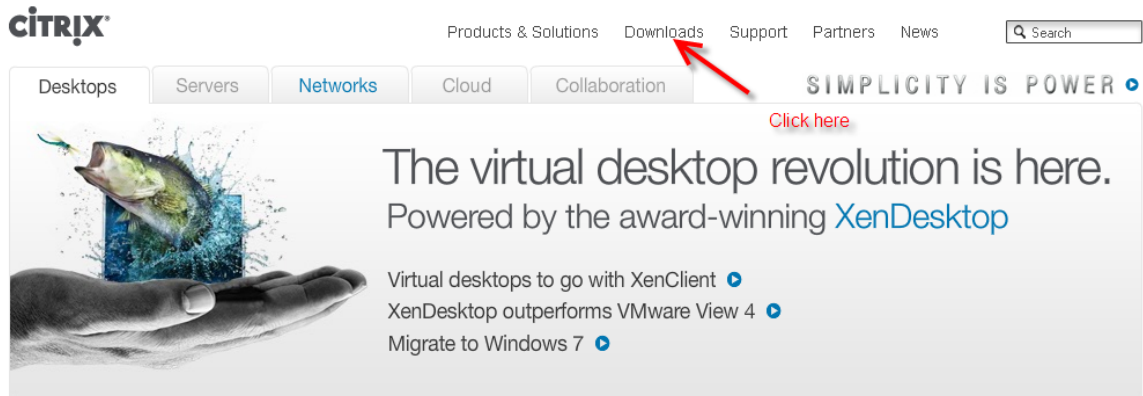
- **Returning students** who have access to the internet at home can easily connect with their school account. Since many students do not check their accounts over the summer, you will need to get the reset password during the first week of school. At home follow the directions below to set up a remote connection with your school account.
- **New students:** During the first week of school you will be given information from your teacher(s) for your new account login and password. If you have internet access at home, you can connect to your school account by following these directions.

Here are step-by-step instructions for downloading and installing a small Citrix engine for your home web browser that allows users to connect to the Rehoboth Citrix network from outside the school network from home using the webpage link of <http://Nfuse.rcsnm.org>, or from the Rehoboth School home page (www.rcsnm.org) click on “Citrix Access” at the bottom left column.

If you login and get a message saying you need to download a program from Citrix, and you click the download button, it will take you to the Citrix homepage. From there follow the instructions below to find the program you need to download and install. PC's use one type of ICA client and Macs have their own client. Mac instructions are at the end of this document.

Procedure for PC:

- You must use Internet Explorer as your web browser first to install this engine. After it is installed you can use other browsers like Firefox. Go to the following website: www.citrix.com
- At the opening screen you will see these options across the top. Click on downloads



- The next screen will look like the following. This is the same screen you get if you select the download button from Nfuse.rcsnm.org when it tells you to download a client program. You want to get Clients.

- Save this .exe program to your Desktop or to your normal download folder on your computer.
- Once the download is complete close out of Internet Explorer.
- Locate the download icon and double click to open it up. Follow the directions to install the new ICA client onto your computer.
- After the install is complete go back and open up your IE web browser again.
- Go to Nfuse.rcsnm.org again and login.
- Now when you open up one of the published Citrix applications it should go right through to the program with no error messages.
