Vaccination Day – January 22

Our school nurse, Eileen Hale, has succeeded in setting up a vaccination clinic here at Rehoboth on Friday, January 22nd. The vaccinations will take place from 9 AM – noon in the K-8 Library and then from 12:30 PM – 3 PM in the Auxiliary gym in the Sports and Fitness Center. Every student will be given a consent form so that they are able to get shots or nasal spray with your permission. As long as the student has this form signed & turned in, you do not need to be present for your child to get the vaccine. If you wish to be present, you may show up during the vaccination hours and be with your child. The vaccination is free.

Please TURN in the form, with a YES or a NO answer, that way we know that you have made a decision and do not have to attempt to contact you again.

The application requirements are as follows: attending a 2 or 4 year college full time, 2.0-3.4 gpa, and ACT of 14 or above.

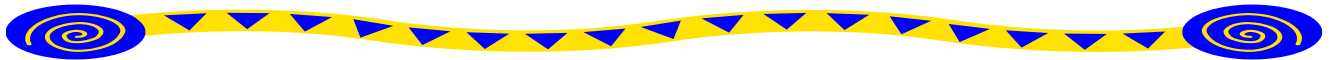
