SOFTBALL PRACTICE OFFICIALLY STARTED ON Feb. 1

Softball practice has officially started and will continue daily starting at 4:45 p.m. and ending no later than 6:45. Due to the weather conditions, softball players will begin weight training in the Sports and Fitness Center from 4:45 to 5:45, then from 5:45 to 6:00, we will make our way to the Aux. Gym where we will begin drills for hitting, pitching, throwing, fielding, base running, proper techniques and fundamentals of Fast Pitch Softball, ending no later than 6:45. With our outdoor practice field covered with snow and mud it is unsafe for us to use. Weather permitting; we hope to soon use the soccer field for our practices. Once the weather improves practice time will move to 3:45 pm to 6:00 pm daily. On days of bad weather (rain, very cold, and wind 20 mph and above) we will again utilize the Aux. Gym providing it is available for that afternoon.

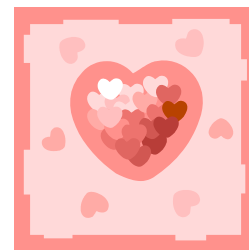
