In N Out Burgers

It was January when I read that the Rehoboth choir had on their schedule a stop at an In N Out Burger restaurant in California. I am from the Midwest and there are no In N Out Burger restaurants here. The name simply made me think of fast food. I wondered what was the attraction?

I was in California soon after that to meet with Rehoboth donors and with Ken Zylstra, Rehoboth's new ambassador for California.. Ken told me to try In N Out. So I did, and the food was real good.

In 1897, after a fast “in and out” experience with mission to the Plains Indians, the Christian Reformed Church undertook a serious effort in ministry of word and deed to Native Americans in the Southwest. This was no “in and out”. Here we are 113 years later and blessed with a wonderful school, now 108 years old.

What an impressive history. But I have something as impressive to share with you. Your High School choir is right now in Southern California to encourage others through songs and testimonies of faith and community service projects. They are indeed wonderful ambassadors of their school. While they are quickly “in and out” of California the choir members are in word and deed spreading a gospel that was first brought to this NM and AZ area by Burghers. Those Burghers (people of European descent) are now joining their voices from heaven with those of this very diverse Rehoboth choir on earth, singing hymns of praise to the Father. The concerts celebrate how God meets His people through Christ, and how we are to carry on His work here on earth. You can be rightly proud that the Rehoboth students are fulfilling the great commission...for having learned from disciples, they have become disciples who make disciples. (Matthew 28:18-20).
