Olson Memorial Scholarship

History of Scholarship

The Olson Memorial Scholarship was established in 1995 to assist families who highly value Christian education but are limited financially to meet the expense of their tuition.

Eligibility

- Applicants must have full admission and enrolled into Elementary School, Middle School, or High School for the current school year
- 2. Applicants who demonstrate an emphasis in Christian education
- 3. Applicants must have financial need
- 4. Applicants must be Native American
- 5. Preference is given to families with two or more children attending Rehoboth
- 6. Applicants must have a signed tuition contract on file with RCS

Award

Recipients will receive at least \$250 tuition assistance scholarship applied over the remaining tuition plan.

Application Requirements

- 1. Application Deadline: Monday, October 28, 2019
- 2. A completed scholarship application form
- 3. Elementary School students: a 100-300 word <u>handwritten</u> essay of your response to the essay statement.
- 4. High School & Middle School students: a 300-500 word <u>typed</u> essay of your response to the essay statement.
- 5. A completed Pastor's report <u>returned by the pastor</u> to the Admission Director
- 6. A signed Tuition Contract Waiver form (one per family is needed & will remain on file for the academic year)

Submit application, essay, waiver form, and pastor's report <u>sent by your church pastor</u> to the Director of Admissions at the Administration building. Electronic submission is accepted and due by midnight. Email to:<u>admissions@rcsnm.org</u>
