

Mina & Colleen Polinder Memorial Scholarship

History of Scholarship

This scholarship is given in memory of two strong Polinder women related to former Superintendent of Rehoboth, Ron Polinder. His mother, Mina, died in a farm accident in 1982 and his wife, Colleen, a former Rehoboth staff member, died of brain cancer in 2012. Both of these women were faithful supporters, loved Rehoboth, and were huge advocates of Christian education. It is thus fitting that these scholarships bear their names. Support for this scholarship comes from their friends and family members.

Eligibility

1. Applicants with full admission and enrolled in 3rd-5th grade only for Elementary School, Middle or High School for the current school year
2. Applicants must have an appreciation for Christian education
3. Applicants must demonstrate outstanding academic work
4. Applicants must have a signed tuition contract

Award

Recipients will receive at least a \$250 tuition assistance scholarship applied over the remaining tuition plan

Application Requirements

1. Application Deadline: **Monday, October 28, 2019**
2. A completed scholarship application form
3. Middle and High School students: a 300-500 word typed essay of your response to the essay statement
4. Elementary School students, 3rd – 5th grade only: a 100-300 word handwritten essay of your response to the essay statement
5. A signed Tuition Contract Waiver form (one per family is needed & will remain on file for the academic year)
