Eligibility

- 1. Applicants with full admission and enrolled into the Elementary, Middle or High School for the current school year
- 2. MS & HS students: Must have a 3.0 cum GPA or better
- 3. Elementary students: No GPA is required instead the latest progress report will be viewed for satisfactory progress.
- 4. Applicants must have a financial need
- 5. Applicants must demonstrate an interest in the STEM field
- 6. Applicants must have a signed tuition contract on file with RCS

Award

Recipient will receive a \$250 tuition assistance scholarship applied over the remaining tuition plan.

Application Requirements

- 1. Application Deadline: Monday, October 28, 2019
- 2. A completed scholarship application form
- 3. Admissions office will gather transcript for GPA or student progress report
- 4. Middle and High School students: A one page TYPED response to the essay question
- 5. Elementary School students: A one page <u>HANDWRITTEN</u> response to the essay question; see further options on application for Kdg & 1st grade students
- 6. A signed Tuition Contract Waiver form (one per family is needed & will remain on file for the academic year)
