

Position Description Teacher

Purpose: Teachers are responsible for creating an environment of rigor, relevance, and relationship that enables students to develop and achieve to their greatest potential.

Report To: Appropriate School Principal (ES, MS, HS)

Supervise: Volunteers and student teachers and teacher assistants as assigned.

Terms of Employment: Employed on a 190-day contract with salary and benefits as approved by the Executive Director.

Qualifications:

- 1. A Personal relationship with Jesus Christ.
- 2. Committed to Christian education and Rehoboth Christian School.
- 3. Knowledgeable about the subject matter assigned to teach.
- 4. Have a bachelor's degree or higher in education and licensed to teach.
- 5. Able to relate well to students.
- 6. Able to discipline students firmly in a loving way.
- 7. Able to develop rapport and work well with parents.
- 8. Skilled in planning and implementing instructional lessons with students.
- 9. Congenial able to work well with other staff members.
- 10. Able to diagnose learning problems and prescribe strategies that enable students to succeed academically.

Responsibilities for a full-time teacher:

- 1. Provide quality instruction to students at the assigned grade level and subject area.
- 2. Integrate Christian values, teachings, and perspectives into all aspects of the instructional program.
- 3. Integrate and use appropriate technological tools for classroom teaching.
- 4. Integrate appropriate local/Native culture into the classroom experience.
- 5. Give leadership in the development of curriculum, using the curriculum maps, in areas of expertise and interest.
- 6. Participate in regular and special staff meetings.
- 7. Communicate regularly with parents, especially when students are having difficulty academically or behaviorally.
- 8. Sponsor, supervise, or support public presentations by school groups as appropriate.
- 9. Sponsor, supervise, or support extracurricular school activities as appropriate.
- 10. Provide feedback to students concerning their performance on a timely basis.
- 11. Perform additional duties as assigned (i.e. playground, lunch, study hall, etc.)
