The Visscher Scholarship was established in 1996 to reward Native American students who have an interest in the STEM field (Science, Technology, Engineering, and Mathematics). Rehoboth has many alumni who study and work in the STEM field. With this scholarship, we hope our current students continue on this passion and interest.

Eligibility

- 1. Applicants must have full admission and enrolled into High School for the current school year
- 2. Applicants must be Native American
- Applicants to have an interest in the STEM field (Science, Technology, Engineering, and Mathematics)
- 4. Applicants must have a financial need
- 5. Applicants are to have a Christian background and be a professed Christian.
- 6. Applicants must have a signed tuition contract on file with RCS

Award

Recipients will receive at least \$250 tuition assistance scholarship applied over the remaining tuition plan.

Application Requirements

- 1. Application Deadline: Monday, October 28, 2019
- 2. A completed scholarship application form
- 3. A 300-500 word <u>typed</u> essay of your response to the essay question
- 4. A completed Pastor's report returned by the pastor to the Admission Director
- A signed Tuition Contract Waiver form (one per family is needed & will remain on file for the academic year)
