



Position Description
Middle School and High School Choral Director Position

Purpose: The Middle School and High School Choir Director will be responsible for five choirs: the 6th grade choir, 7th grade choir, 8th grade choir, High School choir and Cantabile. Through choral music the Director will seek to implement the mission, vision, and core beliefs of Rehoboth Christian School.

Report To: Middle School and High School Principals

Terms of Employment: Employed on a 190-day contract with salary and benefits as approved by the Executive Director. This position is part time unless combined with other duties.

Qualifications:

1. A commitment to the Lordship of Jesus Christ.
2. A commitment to Christian education and Rehoboth Christian School.
3. Knowledgeable about choral music in the middle and high school settings
4. Have a teaching degree, preferably in Music Education or willing to pursue an alternative licensure program which would lead to certification.
5. Able to relate well to students from 6th-12th grade.
6. Passion for and sensitivity to issues having to do with cross cultural interactions.
7. Able to collaborate with staff.

Responsibilities:

1. Develop student appreciation and love for choral music.
2. Develop students' ability to produce a beautiful vocal tone.
3. Equip a student to perform as a group and as an individual.
4. Develop the ability to understand and use the language of music.
5. Use a variety of instructional techniques to help students to learn.
6. Exercise excellent classroom management skills and record keeping skills.
7. Organize thematic concerts
8. Prepare choirs and individuals for assessments and competitions.
9. Increase enthusiasm for music by helping with school musicals and/or other ensembles.
10. Organize tours
11. Coordinate occasional fundraisers.
12. Creatively use choirs to bless the community.
13. Participate in all staff professional development opportunities.
