ROUTE INFORMATION:

- We will ride 34 miles beginning at Cornerstone Ministries in Smith Lake, NM on NN HWY 49 to State HWY 556 to US HWY 66 and end at Rehoboth, NM
- There are seven (7) exchange areas:
 1. Dirt road turnoff on south side of HWY 49 (5.5 miles)
 2. Mariano Lake School on north side of HWY 49 (11.1 miles)
 3. Gate Below Hill on north side of HWY 49 (16.5 miles)
 4. Lunch right on south side of HWY 49 right before turn off to HWY 566 (21.9 miles)
 - Lunch will be provided for all riders, volunteers and the media.
 5. Speedway on west side of HWY 566 (26.5 miles)
 6. Churchrock NHA housing on west side of HWY 566 (29.7 miles)
 7. Fire Rock Casino on north side of HWY 66 (32.2 miles)
- Riders can join at the exchange areas.
- Police are aware of the route including the news media.
- All schools along the way, Mariano Lake School & Catherine Miller School, have been notified of the route.
- Escort vehicle provided.
- Horse trailer and pickup provided for emergency purposes.
