Jordyn has a passion for Dinétah (The geographical area of the Navajo Nation), and she enthusiastically shares about it with anyone interested. When she is home during breaks from college, Jordyn is always up for leading our visiting groups on a hike—especially through locations that are significant to the history and culture of our area. As a geology major at Calvin University, Jordyn can tell people about the rock types and formations they encounter on these walks, but she really loves to share about the unique blessings and challenges of Navajo life and in an even larger sense, Indigenous culture as a whole. Jordyn is proud of her identity as a young, Navajo woman, and she's able to invite other people into her story without making them feel

small or foolish. She has a unique ability to discern when it's best to be gentle with outside perceptions and when a firmer stance is required. No matter what, she cares enough to teach the correct posture to use when learning about a culture different from one's own; and those are powerful learning experiences for everyone who meets her.

Jordyn's talents and perspective bring people together—bridging the gaps that too often divide us in this day and age. She demonstrates the kind of hospitality the Lord wants to see in His followers—one that welcomes people warmly and yet still asks them to step outside of their comfort zones into the life and circumstances of others. When we do that, we come to recognize more deeply the bond we share in Christ.

We've finished the school year at Rehoboth, and once again, we reflect on the way so many of you have made us a part of your lives. You've lifted us up in prayer, you've supported our students, you've volunteered here, and you've blessed us financially. Tuition Assistance Need

We are grateful for the generous gifts we continue to receive that help us meet our annual need for tuition assistance. Through April 30, 2025 we have received \$1,887,702 towards the budgeted annual tuition assistance need for the 2024-2025 school year of \$1,910,000. As we near the end of our fiscal year, we are predicting a financial shortfall of **\$158,000** due to lower than anticipated tuition income and other revenue, coupled with higher than anticipated expenses, primarily in staffing and benefits. We ask you to

consider helping us with an additional gift so that we can meet our year end financial needs.

The SALT program continues to provide the staffing and resources needed to help our Students All Learn Together. As we near the end of the school year, please consider a gift to help fully fund the SALT program. The remaining need for the SALT program for this school year is **\$48,631**.
