Earlier this week, I thought today would be a snow-day, for sure!

Instead, all the predictive expertise of different weather apps proved wrong, and we're having school as usual (although I do see some flurries outside my office window as I'm writing this).

Have you ever had something you're planning get a wrench thrown into the works and go completely awry? Have you been counting on a particular outcome that doesn't come to fruition? Have you had a vision for a particular season of your life that just doesn't go the way you imagined it would?

I ask those questions rhetorically, because I know that we've all experienced those moments. The longer you live, the more often you will know what it's like to think you have something under control or all figured out, only to be reminded that you don't have nearly as much power over your circumstances as you might think.

If you're a Type-A personality like me, that's not a fun feeling to have.

But those moments provide an opportunity for real growth for us as well.

On one of my past trips to Israel, we got to talking about the kinds of platitudes we share with each other in the midst of hard, frustrating, or grief-filled circumstances:

"Remember, when God closes a door, He opens a window . . ."

"Everything happens for a reason . . ."

And the ever-popular, "God will never give you more than you can handle."

Our teacher got really intense about that one and said, "God will absolutely give you more than you can handle so that you learn that there's no way you can cope, live, and flourish without Him."

As we embark on this New Year, I'm praying to "lean not on my own understanding" as Proverbs tells us. I want to be quicker to remember that I should first seek His will before coming up with my own grand ideas. And I especially want to remember that people walking through challenging times don't need me to try to say something that wraps up all their problems in a neat little bow. It's much more important to be a shoulder to lean on . . . or cry on—to listen more than speak, and by our presence to remind them they are part of a family that loves them, the family of God.


