#### **ACE Scholarship of New Mexico**

This is a great scholarship for parents who are sending their students to a tuition- based private school like Rehoboth. They offer from \$1000 - \$4000 per student depending on grade. In order to get this scholarship for next year, you do need to apply for it by **April 15, 2024.** Please follow the complete instructions and details under the Inside Scoop section starting on page 8. Here is a chart of the income -financial guidelines to see if you qualify. Those who received this scholarship last year must reapply but you do not need to download your 2023 taxes.

#### New Student applications for the 2024-2025 year:

The new student applications are now available. If you are a current parent interested in adding an additional child, you can fill out an application within your Family Portal account. When completed we will be connecting with you on the next steps. If you know anyone interested in applying, they can start an <u>application online here</u>.

**ACE Scholarship:** It is very important that you use these links below to login. You will first have to update your FACTS account then go to another link to fill out the ACE Scholarship application. Again, this is a free and if a payment portion comes up for you, you need to log out and use the steps below to connect it all.

Go here First: We are finding out that the incorrect website URL is being used for your FACTS signin- <u>don't use the</u> URL you used last year.

*Instead, use the following link* <u>HERE\_(https://online.factsmgt.com/grant-aid/inst/46T5C/landing-page</u>) this will connect you with Rehoboth Christian School. If Rehoboth Christian School comes up you are using the correct website and you can select the year 2024-2025 and answer all the required questions - you can also download your 2023 tax documents here. Make sure you submit it. If Rehoboth Christian School does <u>not</u> come up, then you are not using the right URL for the website, go back and use the link. Here is a screen shot of what you should see when you go to the website.

## Second: Once that is complete please go <u>HERE</u> to fill out the ACE scholarship application. Please use the same sign in as FACTS (from step 1).

If the ACE scholarship is still asking you to pay then you have not connected with Rehoboth Christian School. **YOU SHOULD NOT BE PAYING FOR THE ACE SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION**. Please start over with the first link.

Here are some other details to note when applying:

- 1. We will be taking care of the application fee
- 2. The application deadline is April 15th.
- 3. Arizona families can apply
- 4. Applications are one per family
- 5. Please fill out if you are financially eligible ASAP, see below.. Be sure to upload all the documents needed.
- 6. To complete, you need the following:
  - a. 2023 tax forms
  - b. Social security, disability, housing allowance, food stamps, child support documentation, and any documentation of additional sources of income that are not reported on your 1040.

#### Lynx Scholarship:

If there are circumstances that are making it difficult for you to pay your tuition, you can apply for the <u>LYNX</u> <u>SCHOLARSHIPS</u>.

**Tuition payments:** A reminder that every month, a tuition payment needs to be paid. You can make your payments by phone through credit (505-863-4412), at our administration building, mail in payment, or use our free service of <u>FACTS</u>. Every credit card payment has a fee.
