Drop off/Pick up Loop

As you drop off and pick up your students in the gravel loop, please use one single lane for your student to exit and enter your vehicle. It is unsafe for students to walk in front of vehicles to a second lane. Thank you for helping keep all our students safe!

Winter Weather

Wow, what beauty and wonder we have been blessed with these past few weeks! Just a reminder to send students to school with warm clothes, mittens, and shoes. Many students have an extra pair of shoes or slippers to change into in their classrooms, that's great!

Behind the elementary and middle school building we have a fantastic sledding hill that students can play on at recess when there is enough snow. So, students are able to bring their own sleds to school if they wish.

In the mornings, we let students inside at 7:45am if the temperature is below 20 degrees. If it's windy, but between 20-30 degrees, we may also decide to let students in. These same guidelines help us determine if students go outside for morning and lunch recesses.

Bullying: Love and Logic Webinar

<u>Re enrollment:</u> For all current families, re-enrollment for the 2024-2025 school year will begin on **January 16th at 5pm**. Here are some details to know:

- 1. One parent will receive an email that the re-enrollment packet is open in their Family Portal.
- 2. Only one parent is considered the "responsible parent" for re-enrollment and will get the packet for their child(ren).
- 3. The email will contain a link to the Family Portal.
- 4. The "responsible parent" needs to have a username and password set up with their Family Portal. To get yourself set up for a Parent Portal, <u>click here.</u> If you need to reset your password follow the prompts.

Lastly, there is a competition! The class with the highest percentage of re-enrollment by January 31st at 5pm will receive a class prize.

<u>Tuition payments</u>: A reminder that every month, a tuition payment needs to be paid. You can make your payments by phone through credit (505-863-4412), at our administration building, mail in payment, or use our free service of <u>FACTS</u>. Every credit card payment has a fee.




I Believe: Athletics
