### **Table Talk**

I like crossing things off lists. Almost every day, when I get to my office in the morning, I make a list of all of the things I hope to accomplish that day. Sometimes, I even pad it with extra things that I know will be easy to do so that I get some positive momentum to carry me through the tougher tasks.

At this time of year, things are busy at school <u>and</u> at home, meaning that my lists get longer and longer. We're beginning the budget cycle for next school year. Basketball season has started, where I help coach the boys high school team. There are concerts and senior presentations, parties and final exams, decorating around the house and shopping for gifts, hosting guests and planning for travel. The list can get overwhelming at times.

And then I remember one of the lessons we learned in Israel about sheep and shepherds. For those of you who work with sheep or have family members who do, I think this will resonate with you. Herding sheep in the desert and guiding them to food is not an easy task. Often, the menu consists of small clumps of grass fed by some of the scarce rain or dew that comes through the region. Those small clumps are the "green pastures" David writes about in Psalm 23. There aren't any meadows of waist high alfalfa in the Judean wilderness.

As the sheep munch on their meager clumps of grass, they get just enough energy to make the trek to the next clump of grass, and so on and so on throughout the day. Desert life is challenging. Rarely is there anything extra. But every day, the shepherd leads the sheep to just enough food and just enough water to make it through the day.

Just enough.

As my list looms large, it's a great reminder that the Lord will give me just enough energy, just enough empathy, just enough determination to make it through the task in front of me. I don't need to worry about everything all at once. My shepherd leads me exactly where I need to go and gives me exactly what I need for the moment.

He's your shepherd too.

I pray these thoughts give you strength and peace as we embark on this Advent season and anticipate anew the birth of our Messiah, Jesus. I love walking this journey with each of you!

#### RCHS First Semester Exam Schedule — December 2024

As a reminder and for those who are taking high school exams for the first time: Students do not need to be at school if they do not have a scheduled exam for a given time slot. However, if they are in school, they must report to their scheduled class and teacher. Students will take their exams during the scheduled time for their class period, unless authorized by their teacher. Students must report on time for their exams, and late arriving students will not be admitted to their exams.

When finished with exams for the day, students may sign out with parent permission if they have transportation home. Students must stay in their designated rooms or study spaces both before and during exam periods. If students miss an exam period, they can make it up on Thursday 12/19 or during another exam period when they are not already taking a test. 
