

Middle School Matters

Media and Your Mid-Schooler

Dear Parents,

As I (Gail DeYoung) meet with your mid school age children, we will often talk about technology, cell phones, media, the internet, screen time, and all things that seem to consume much of our lives.

We have done an excellent job of watching over our childrens' lives in the real world while doing our best to protect them from people and situations that may bring harm. One concern that I have is that we have a much more difficult time protecting our children from the virtual world of their phones, media, internet, etc. I have worked with several of our mid school students who have been approached by predators online. In some cases this "person" just wants to be a friend. However, oftentimes, their purpose is to "groom" trusting kids to do any number of things such as give out personal information, meet with the predator and send pictures of themselves and eventually sexual images to the predator. In all cases, our children are fearful of their parents finding out.

One site that has come up repeatedly is a video game called "roblox". Roblox is a video game/social platform where kids can play games as well as interact online with both people they know and people they don't know.

Because of concern from parents about these things, Roblox now allows parents to go in and set limits on who their children can interact with through the site. If you go to google.com and type in "roblox parental controls" along with your child's password for the site, you can set limits on who and what they can do on this site. It is just another way of protecting your child from social media!


