What is a QPR Gatekeeper?

A gatekeeper is someone in a position to recognize a crisis and the warning signs that someone may be contemplating suicide.

QPR Gatekeepers can be anyone, but include:

- Youth (16 years and older)
- Doctors
- First Responders
- Mental Health Professionals
- And You!

As a certified QPR gatekeeper you will learn to:

1. Recognize the warning signs of suicide.
2. Increase awareness of stigma and understand suicide as a public health issue.
3. Know how to access local and national referral resources.
4. Know how to offer hope.
5. Know how to get help and save a life.
