### History of Scholarship

Beginning in 1995, this scholarship is given in honor of Iva H. Lauber and Harrison N. Lauber in support of Christian education to Native American students. Iva was a missionary on the Navajo reservation and met Harrison as a young child at Good News Mission in Houck, AZ. When he was starting school, Harrison needed a place to live near the bus route, so his parents asked if he could stay with Iva. He earned his keep by filling the coal bin and such. By the age of seven, Harrison was legally adopted by Iva Lauber. Harrison had many opportunities because of this wonderful missionary who opened her home and her heart to the Navajo people. Grandma Iva and her adopted son, Harrison Lauber, have grandchildren and great grandchildren who have attended Rehoboth Christian School.

## Eligibility

- 2. Applicants must be Native American
- 3. Applicants must be a professed Christian
- 4. Applicants must have financial need and a signed tuition contract
- 5. Preference is given first to the families of the I-40 West District of the Rehoboth Christian School Association.

- 3. Middle and High School students: a 300-500 word <u>typed</u> essay of your response to the statement
- 4. Elementary School students: a 100-300 word <u>typed or handwritten essay</u> of your response to the statement
- 5. A completed Pastor's report returned by the pastor to the Admissions Office
