History of Scholarship

The Hoelscher Scholarship began in memory of Maria Hoelscher. Maria was a German exchange student attending Rehoboth who died in April of 2006 in an automobile accident. Service and music characterized her life of worship. She was a bundle of joy with a lot of energy. As a student, her faith grew stronger while a part of choir and attending Rehoboth.

Eligibility

1. Applicants enrolled into High School for the current school year
2. Applicants must be Native American
3. Applicants must be a professed Christian
4. Applicants must have a financial need and a signed tuition contract with RCS
5. Preference will be given to high school students participating in choir, students studying a foreign language, or students who have an interest in international studies.

Award

Recipients will receive scholarship applied over the remaining tuition plan

3. A 300-500 word **typed** essay of your response to the essay question
