History of Scholarship

The Olson Memorial Scholarship was established in 1995 to assist families who highly value Christian education but are limited financially to meet the expense of their tuition.

Eligibility

1. Applicants enrolled into Elementary School or Middle School for the current school year
2. Applicants who demonstrate an emphasis in Christian education
3. Family must have financial need and a signed tuition contract with RCS
4. Applicants must be Native American
5. Preference is given to families with two or more children attending Rehoboth

Award

Recipients will receive scholarship applied over the remaining tuition plan

Application Requirements

1. Application Deadline: **Tuesday, November 12, 2024**
2. A completed scholarship application form
3. Elementary School students: a 100-300 word handwritten essay of your response to the essay statement.
4. Middle School students: a 300-500 word typed essay of your response to the essay statement.
5. The parent's section of the application completed
6. A completed Pastor's report returned by the pastor to the Admission Office.

Submit application, essay, and pastor's report sent by your church pastor to the Admissions Office at the Administration building. Electronic submission is accepted and due by midnight on Tuesday, November 12th. Email to: admissions@rcsnm.org
