

# Mina & Colleen Polinder Memorial Scholarship



## History of Scholarship

This scholarship is given in memory of two strong Polinder women related to former Superintendent of Rehoboth, Ron Polinder. His mother, Mina, died in a farm accident in 1982 and his wife, Colleen, a former Rehoboth staff member, died of brain cancer in 2012. Both of these women were faithful supporters, loved Rehoboth, and were huge advocates of Christian education. It is thus fitting that these scholarships bear their names. Support for this scholarship comes from their friends and family members.

## Eligibility

1. Applicants enrolled in Elementary School in the 3<sup>rd</sup>-5<sup>th</sup> grade only, Middle School, and High School for the current school year
2. Applicants must have an appreciation for Christian education
3. Applicants must demonstrate outstanding academic work
4. Applicants must have a financial need and a signed tuition contract with RCS

Recipients will receive scholarship applied over the remaining tuition plan

## Application Requirements

1. Application Deadline: **Tuesday, November 12, 2024**
2. A completed scholarship application form
3. Middle and High School students: a 300-500 word typed essay of your response to the essay statement
4. Elementary School students, 3<sup>rd</sup> – 5<sup>th</sup> grade only: a 100-300 word handwritten essay of your response to the essay statement.
5. The parent's section of the application completed
