Eligibility

1. Applicants enrolled into High School for the current school year
2. Applicants must be Native American
3. Applicants must be a professed Christian
4. Applicants family must have a financial need and a signed tuition contract with RCS

Award

Recipients will receive scholarship applied over the remaining tuition plan

Application Requirements

1. Application Deadline: **Tuesday, November 12, 2024**
2. A completed scholarship application form
3. The parent's section of the application completed
4. A 300-500 word **typed** essay of your response to the statement
